Summary of the 116th Council Plenary Session held on 17 June 2021

1. The ensuing items were considered and approved by Council:

Financial and Budget

- The proposed consolidated budget plan of the University for 2021/22.
- The proposed Investment Strategy and Governance to replace the original Investment Policy Statement as a guiding document for the investment of the University's Core Capital Pool.
- The appointment of one of the Trustees of The HKUST Staff Superannuation Scheme for a two-year period from 17 June 2021, and the affixing of the common seal of the University to the Deed of Appointment.

Human Resources

• The proposed appointment of the President as the Acting Provost, with effect from 1 June 2021, following the departure of Professor Lionel Ni from the Provost position.

2021 Main Congregation

• The proposed plan, including the sessional arrangements, of the University Congregation in 2021.

Donation and Naming

- The acceptance of the third donation from Yue Xiu Enterprises (Holdings) Limited 越秀企業 (集團)有限公司 to support the academic and research development of HKUST.
- The acceptance of donation from The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust for the "Sustainable Consumer Program" and the naming of the Program after the donor.

Membership - Appointments

- The recommendation to the Chancellor, the proposed appointment of a candidate and re-appointment of a Council Member to the Council, with effect from 1 August 2021; and the appointments of two Deans to the Council later this year by annual rotation.
- The proposed memberships of Council Committees in 2021/22, following the annual review exercise.

Others

- The proposed amendments to the Terms of Reference (ToR) and/or Scope of Responsibilities (SoR) of a number of Council Committees.
- The appointment of the external auditor for the University and the group entities for the financial years 2021/22 to 2025/26.
- The authorization of the Legal Counsel to make Statutory Declarations for two trade mark registrations for and on behalf of the University.
- The proposed schedules for both the election of a staff and a student member to the Council in 2021 and the proposed revisions to the related election regulations for the former.
- 2. Council conferred degrees to 744 qualified candidates who had been approved by the Senate as having satisfied all requirements for graduation, in the First Session of the 29th Congregation.
- 3. Council also took note of the Investment Operational Practice which is for documentation of operational details regarding the investment of the Core Capital Pool of the University.
